## Mid-Year Goals

Using NWEA as the district/school selected benchmark for grades 6-8 in math (fall), the percent of students scoring average or above will increase from fall to mid-year. Progress will be measured using a benchmark assessment at mid-year.

- Students scoring average or above average decreased from 64\% (fall) and $58 \%$ (winter) to $52 \%$ (spring) on the NWEA assessment.

Using NWEA as the district/school selected benchmark for grades 6-8 in reading (fall), the percent of students scoring average or above will increase from fall to midyear. Progress will be measured using a benchmark assessment at mid-year.
-Students scoring average or above average decreased from 73\% (fall) and 76\% (winter) to 62\% (spring) on the NWEA assessment.

Using NWEA as the district/school selected benchmark for grades 6-8 in language usage (fall), the percent of students scoring average or above will increase from fall to mid-year. Progress will be measured using a benchmark assessment at mid-year.
-Students scoring average or above average decreased from 78\% (fall) and 80\% (winter) to 65\% (spring) on the NWEA assessment.
