As noted on our COVID-19 Dashboard here: <https://greenspireschool.org/transparency/>, on January 31, 2022, we learned of at least one School Associated Case of COVID-19 in a student or faculty/staff member at The Greenspire School - High School.

The Greenspire School - High School will remain open at this time. We are working with the Grand Traverse County Health Department to identify any close contacts of school associated cases of COVID-19. **Due to our mitigation efforts and current indoor masking policy, the exposure to others was significantly reduced.** Anyone identified as a close contact will be notified by the health department as a part of the COVID-19 investigation process. Please answer the phone if the health department contacts you, as a contact tracer may be trying to reach you with important information.

The CDC recommends the following actions to help limit the spread of COVID-19:

- Get vaccinated
- Wear a mask (covering mouth and nose)
- Practice social distancing
- Practice frequent hand washing
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- Stay home if you are sick and get tested

Thank you for understanding that, due to medical privacy laws, we are not able to release the names of individual(s) with COVID-19. We will continue to communicate changes and updates with you. With your participation, we believe we can maintain a safe environment while also providing a quality education.
