What is Optional Test Out Day?

Optional Test Out Day is a state-mandated requirement for all Michigan Public High Schools. On this day, a student has the option to "test out" of a course and receive course credit.

Why choose this option?

Students who are accelerated may want to test out of courses in order to advance their high school curriculum. Students also may want to test out of courses that they have previously failed.

What do these tests look like?

At GHS, we distribute paper tests for all subject areas. These tests cover the state standards that adequately represent a semester long course. **These tests are lengthy and challenging to ensure that the student proves mastery of the course standards.** The Physical Education test has a physical component as well as a paper component. Each subject area test could take up to an hour to complete, but student pacing varies. Students may use the entire 6-hour testing period to complete anywhere from 1-6 tests.

How would a student prepare for these tests?

All study guides will be distributed to registered students on Friday, May 5th.

This allows for 2-weeks of study time.

Behavioral Expectations

Students must remain silent during testing. Once your test is complete, you will move on to your next test or leave the testing room to go home. One student at a time may use the restroom.

Disruptive students will be asked to leave and will **not** have an opportunity to retest.

After Testing

Test Score Letters will be sent/mailed to you and your guardian the week of May 22nd. Students who achieve a 78% or higher on a course exam will receive a **CR (Credit)** for that course on their high school transcript. They will not receive a grade for the course.
