The Vision

The Greenspire School team of educators wishes to build an educational experience rooted in academic excellence alongside a culturally-responsive, experiential project-based curriculum.

Project-Based Learning

Project Based Learning (PBL) is a teaching method in which students learn by actively engaging in real-world and personally meaningful cross-curricular projects.

The PBL process emphasizes Voice and Choice, Collaboration, Critique and Revision, Inquiry, and Reflection to empower exploration, design, being a self-advocate, and create meaning within their learning.

Environmental Focus

The Greenspire School focuses on rigorous project based learning within an environmentally focused setting. Student work is focused on making purposeful connections between individuals, communities, and the environment.







Planning for Success

- Students can be dropped off beginning at 8:15am. School starts at 8:30.

Attendance

Students begin leaving campus for classes as early as 8:30. If your student is going to be tardy, please call us to let us know as this may impact their ability to join their class when they arrive.

Similarly, students may be up to 45 minutes from campus at any time. If you need to pick up your student early, we need to know ahead of time so that we can keep your student from heading out on the trails.



Student Grades

Standards-Based Grading

Greenspire utilizes a grading system known as standards-based grading. Research has shown that standards-based grading helps students take ownership of their learning and leads to higher rates of academic achievement. When completing a standard (known as a milestone) in a project at Greenspire, students will receive a number rating. Based on this number, students will either move on to work on mastering another standard or keep working at the current standard. The following is a brief description of what each number means.

Number Rating	Grade	Description
4	А	Complex content—a performance beyond what a standard requires
3	В	Target content–the level of learning required for all students
2	С	Basic knowledge or skill for mastering the target content
1	D	Minimal content knowledge-with help
0	F	Content standard not demonstrated-with help

Because Greenspire is a project based learning school, we believe skills like participation and collaboration are important for students to develop and students are assessed on these skills as well as target milestones.

The student and staff member will try to verbally (or via email) solve the concern together. These discussions should be respectful, honoring, and solution-oriented. If a student feels that their concern was not resolved, the parent/guardian may become involved. At this time, the parent/guardian should email the staff member.

Stopping/dropping across the street from Greenspire


Allowing students to walk alongside the car line

- Do not pick up or drop off in the red area
- Pull up to the furthest possible position indicated in green
- Have your child organize his/her possessions before stopping
- Exit to the south; do not make a U-turn adjacent to the school

CORE VALUES
