ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE & ARTS DEGREE PROGRAM ENROLLMENT STANDARDS

- Families must provide their own transportation or use public transit to the NMC campus for in-person courses unless they are held at the University Center.
- Student NMC courses will only be paid for when taken during the GHS school year. (NMC Fall: August-December and Spring: January-May Semesters)
- GHS Students must pass their courses with a 1.0 or higher at NMC for The Greenspire District to pay for the course. If a GHS student does not pass the course with a 1.0 or higher, course payment defaults to the student's primary guardian/parent of record. *
- The Greenspire School is provided access to all NMC/GHS dual-enrolled student information and records. However, GHS will not monitor students during their NMC courses.
- Student is required to meet with their GHS counselor once per year and their NMC advisor/counselor once per semester (October and March) to review their status in the program and plan for the following semester
- EMC Students are required to attend EMC Council meetings on Fridays once a month
- When students complete their college course(s) for the semester, they are required to participate in one of the following activities for one class period per day:
 - Act as student tutors or teaching assistants
 - Work on a school improvement project
 - Work on a mini-personal curriculum project or an approved online course

**Typically a 2.0 is required to transfer credits to another college or university. Transfer credits are at the discretion of the institution transferring in the credits. Please see that institution's policy for more information.*
